Internet Explorer (versions 5.x-6.x)

To change the text size in Internet Explorer (versions 5.x-6.x) *for Windows*, you must first disable style sheets. To do so, follow the directions below:

- 1) From the **Menu Bar**, select **Tools** and click **Internet Options**
- 2) Select the **General** tab and click the box entitled **Accessibility**
- 3) Ensure that all three buttons under **Formatting** are checked
- 4) Click OK in **Accessibility** dialog box
- 5) Click OK in **Internet Options** dialog box (style sheets are disabled)
- 6) Click Refresh
- 7) From the **Menu Bar**, select **View**
- 8) Scroll to **Text Size** and choose your preference

Internet Explorer (version 7.0 and greater)

To change the text size in Internet Explorer (version 7.0 and greater) *for Windows*:

- 1) From the Menu Bar, select **View**
- 2) Scroll to **Text Size** and choose your preference

Mozilla

To change the text size in Mozilla *for Windows*:

- 1) From the **Menu Bar**, select **Edit > Preferences**
- 2) Double click **Appearance** and select **Fonts**
- 3) On the right panel set the font size. (Minimum font size can also be set)

Firefox

To make a temporary text size change in Firefox *for Windows*:

From the Firefox **Menu Bar** select **View > Text Size > Increase**. (This will cause the text to display on the web page one size larger)

To make a permanent text size change:

- 1) From the Firefox **Menu Bar**, select **Tools > Options**
- 2) Click on **General**
- 3) Click on **Fonts & Colors**
- 4) Set the font size. (Minimum font size can also be set)

Netscape (version 4.x)

To change the text size in Netscape (version 4.x) *for Windows*, you must first disable style sheets. To do so, follow the directions below:

- 1) From the **Menu Bar**, select **Edit > Preferences**
- 2) Click on the **Advanced** category and deselect the item entitled **Enable Style Sheets**
- 3) Click OK (style sheets are disabled)
- 4) Click **Reload**
- 5) From the **Menu Bar**, select **View**
- 6) Scroll down to **Increase Font**

Netscape (version 6.0 and greater)

To change the text size in Netscape (version 6.0 and greater) *for Windows*:

- 1) From the **Menu Bar**, select **View**
- 2) Scroll down to **Text Zoom** and choose your preference

Internet Explorer (versions 5.x and greater)

To change the text size in Internet Explorer (versions 5.x and greater) *for Mac OS*:

- 1) From the **Menu Bar**, select **View**
- 2) Scroll down to **Text Zoom** and choose your preference

Mozilla

To make a temporary text size change in Mozilla *for Mac OS*:

From the Mozilla **Menu Bar**, select **View > Text Zoom > Increase**. (This will cause the text to display on the web page one size larger)

To make a permanent text size change in Mozilla *for Mac OS*:

- 1) From the Mozilla **Menu Bar**, select **Preferences**
- 2) Click on **Appearance** then click on **Fonts**
- 3) Set the font size

Firefox

To make a temporary text size change in Firefox *for Mac OS*:

From the Firefox **Menu Bar** select **View > Text Size > Increase**. (This will cause the text to display on the web page one size larger)

To make a permanent text size change in Firefox *for Mac OS*:

- 1) From the Firefox **Menu Bar**, select **Firefox > Preferences**
- 2) Click on **Fonts & Colors**
- 3) Set the font size. (Minimum font size can also be set)

Safari

To make a text size change in Safari *for Mac OS*:

- 1) From the Safari **Menu Bar**, select **Preferences**
- 2) Click **Appearance**
- 3) To change the standard font or fixed-width font used in pages, click the appropriate **Select** button and change the font size using the slider bar

Netscape (version 4.x)

To change the text size in Netscape (version 4.x) *for Mac OS* you must first disable style sheets. To do so, follow the directions below:

- 1) From the **Menu Bar**, select **Edit > Preferences**
- 2) Click on the **Advanced** category and deselect the item entitled **Enable Style Sheets**
- 3) Click OK (style sheets are disabled)
- 4) Click **Reload**
- 5) From the **Menu Bar**, select **View**
- 6) Scroll down to **Increase Font**
